

**HOLY NAME SOCIETY  
CHURCH OF THE HOLY FAMILY  
MINUTES OF MEETING ON MARCH 2, 2013**

The meeting was called to order by President Pelliccotti and opened with a joint prayer by the 21 members in attendance. Minutes of the February 2 meeting were read by the secretary and approved as read.

**TREASURER'S REPORT:** Rick Cargill summarized financial activity of the past month, leaving a treasury balance of \$4377.94,

**STANDING COMMITTEES**

- **SICK AND VIGIL:** Nothing reported
- **MEMBERSHIP:** No new members

**OLD BUSINESS**

- **CASINO NIGHT:** Rick reported that costs for Casino Night were \$1350.80, leaving a profit of \$2625.45, of which \$2535.27 is available for donations.

**NEW BUSINESS**

- **LARRY CORWIN:** President Pelliccotti thanked all those who were able to attend the wake and subsequent funeral of our long time member, Larry Corwin. A HNS donation of \$100 was made to Boy Scouts Camp Tuscarora in memory of Larry.
- **MASS FOR DECEASED MEMBERS:** This Mass was held today because of a scheduling conflict this past December. Norm Bardales reported a good turn out by the membership, and he received several warm thanks from widows of deceased members.
- **HNS TRANSPORTATION TO MASS SERVICE:** Mike stated that a Driver Training Class is to be held in Room 2 from 2:00pm to 8:00pm on Sunday, March 30, for all those who plan to drive or serve as assistants. The need for driver training for assistants was said to be probable, but not definite. The cost of \$40 per person will be paid by the parish. Notice of this class will be advertised in the bulletin for other members of the parish, but only for those who plan to be drivers or assistants.
- **MARDI GRAS PARTY:** Dave Hores summarized the various games and activities planned for this event which is to be held in McCabe Hall starting at 6:00pm on Tuesday, March 4<sup>th</sup>. Cost will be \$5 and it was recommended that members invite other parish members who might be interested. Nick Smedira has done the shopping and will be cooking a pasta, meatball, and salad dinner. Rolls, some additional desserts, and a few bottles of wine are to be donated by members.
- **ASH WEDNESDAY SOUP SUPPER:** Nick Smedira said he had shopped for the supplies to make the Clam **Chowder** and Hearty Vegetable Soups that will be prepared by Gerry Kohut and Paul Scudder. A good-will offering will be available at the meal, and both soups will be sold for \$6 per quart after Mass. A sign-up sheet was passed around for help in slicing and dicing after the daily Mass on Tuesday morning and for help on Wednesday in setting up before Mass and cleaning up after the supper.
- **HNS OFFICERS ELECTIONS:** It was announced that this election will be held at the April meeting.
- **MALVERN RETREAT:** A new coordinator for this event will be needed to replace the late Larry Corwin. This will be taken up at the next meeting.
- **SPRING BLOOD DRIVE:** Gene Tye reported that this is planned for Monday, March 31, from 1:30pm to 6:30pm. HNS volunteers to take down the tables and chairs from the prior Fish Dinner will be needed. It was tentatively agreed that this could be accomplished by members attending the Driver Training Class, either before class or during a break in the class.

- **DONATIONS FROM CASINO NIGHT PROCEEDS:** A lengthy discussion ensued on Father's suggestion for a replacement of the accordion door with a door providing much more effective sound proofing between class rooms across the hall from room 2. It was agreed that no more than about \$1000 should be provided by HNS, and the remainder should come from other groups. The consensus was that HNS donations should continue to be provided to parish groups that are not part of the general parish expense, that the final selection of these groups, and the amount of donations, should continue to be decided by the membership. It was suggested that an alternative, perhaps less expensive, would be a drapery supplement to the current door. Other donations suggested were robes for the smaller altar servers, and contributions to be determined for Extreme Youth Group, Faith Formation, and CYO. Mike will query these groups about their needs. Steve Cole suggested that the various groups for whom donations are appropriate be encouraged to think ahead and come to the HNS with specific requests. A list of proposed donations will be voted on at the next meeting. Norm Bardales will look into the cost of a memorial stone pavers in the garden for our recently canonized Saint Marianne Cope and Kateri Tekakwitha
